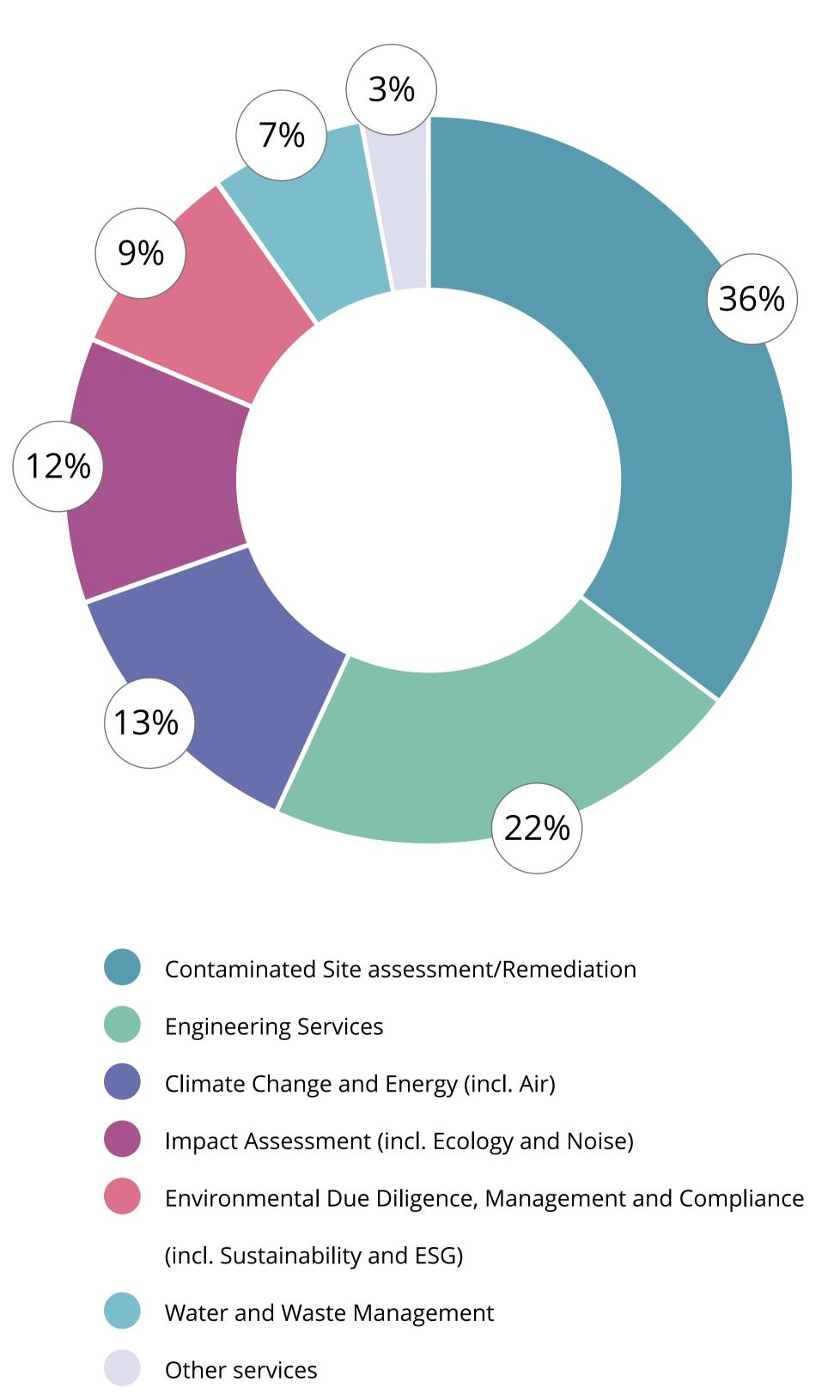
Financial results

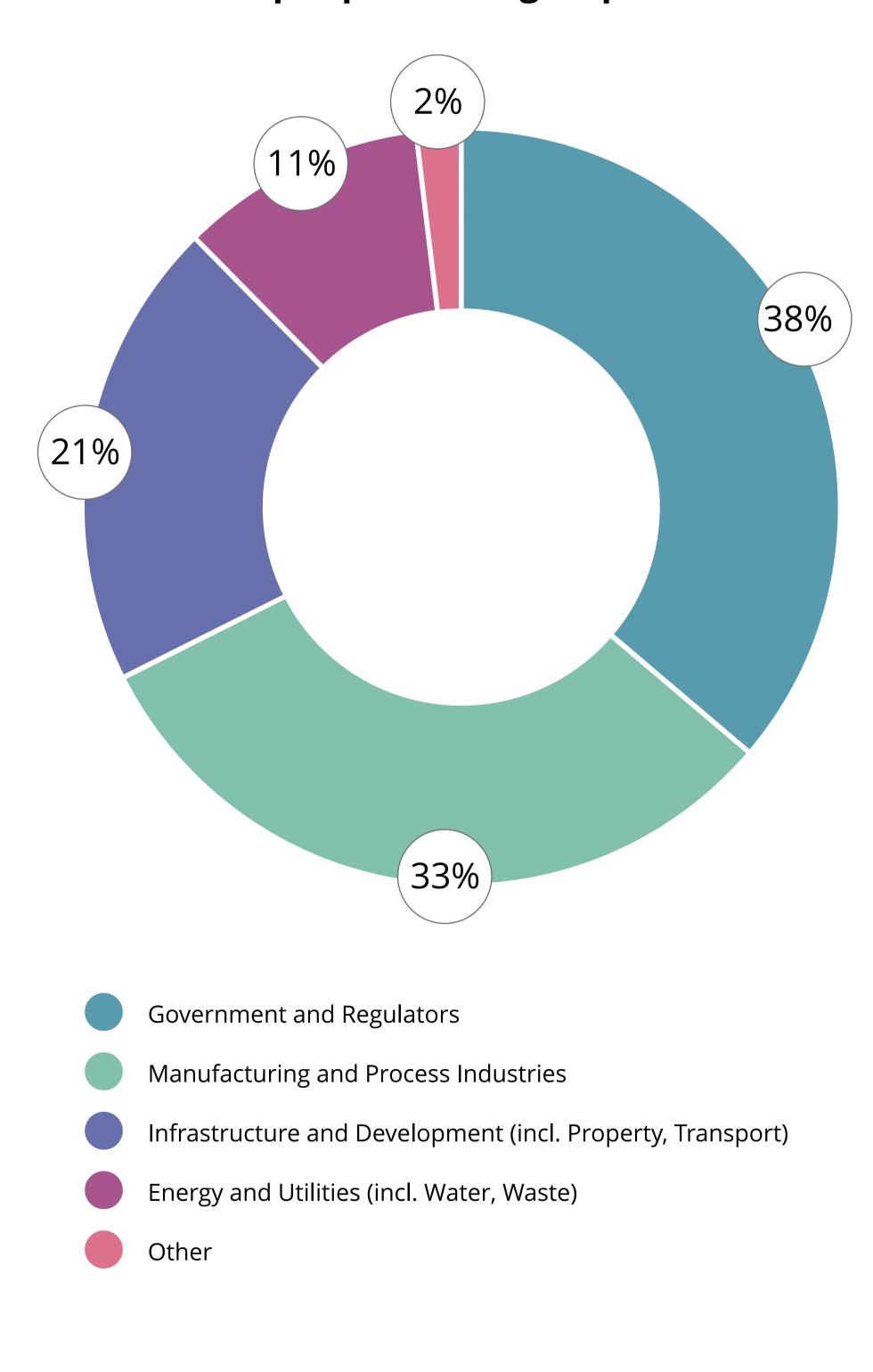
In 2020, we took important next steps towards our living ambition. Our continuing focus on international industrial markets for both consultancy and monitoring activities has proven to be a successful strategy. In addition, our sharpened market profile combined with new propositions in the public sector have resulted in increased turnover in 2020. TAUW Group's turnover grew by more than 4%, from EUR 138 million in 2019 to EUR 144 million in 2020. Our EBITDA increased by more than 16% to EUR 9.9 million and the EBITDA margin improved to almost 7%. Moreover, our cash flow improved significantly, thanks to the strong results and a significant improvement of our working capital. We are very proud of these results.

Turnover split per client group 2020



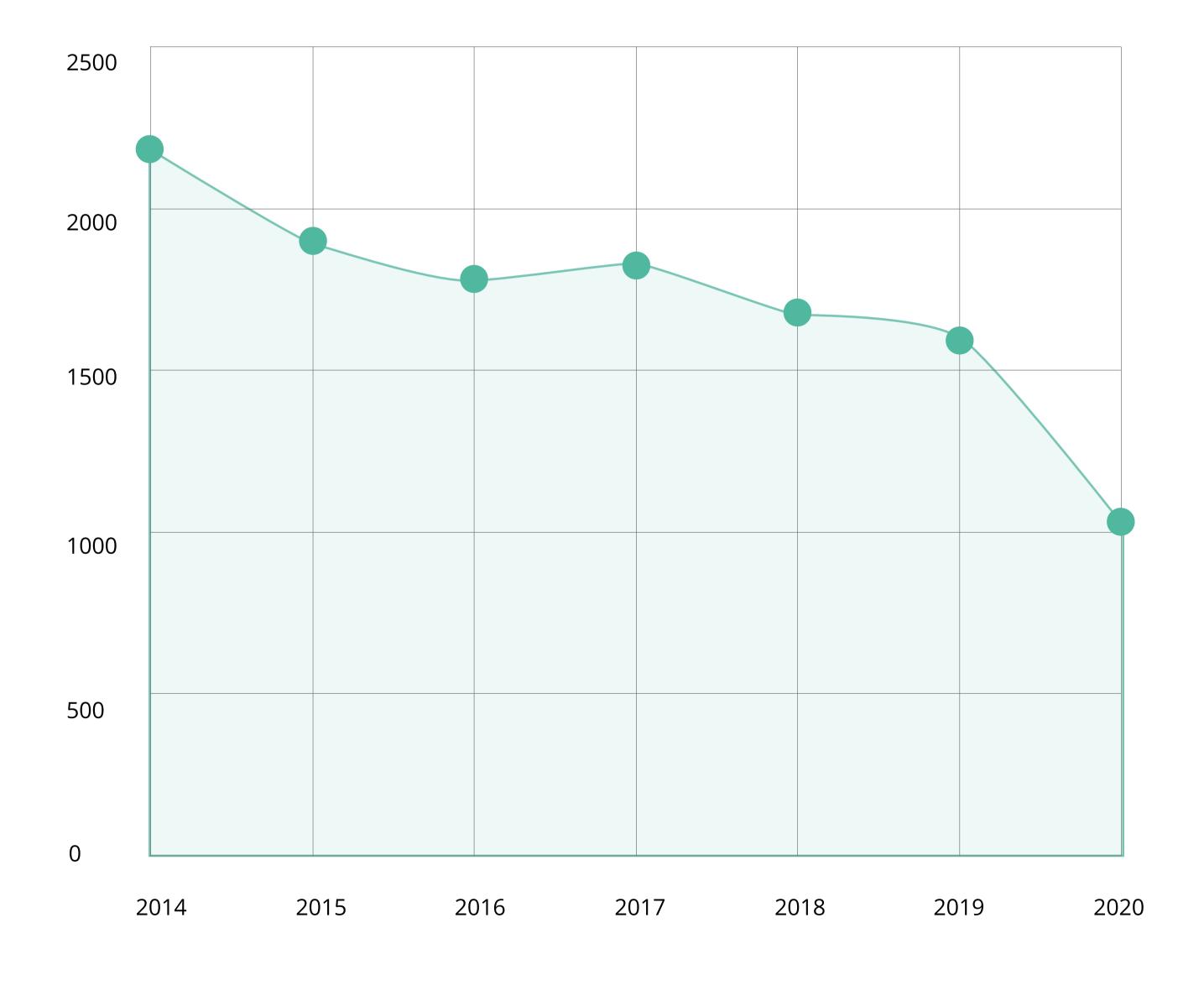


In 2020, we used considerably less energy in our buildings. In the Netherlands we monitor this very precisely. There we have used 16.8% less electricity and 7.2% less natural gas than in 2019. We also see clear differences for our (company) cars. We see a decrease in fuel consumption of 39.8%. Corona has obviously had an effect on these figures.

Emissions from business transport and combustion of natural gas in the buildings

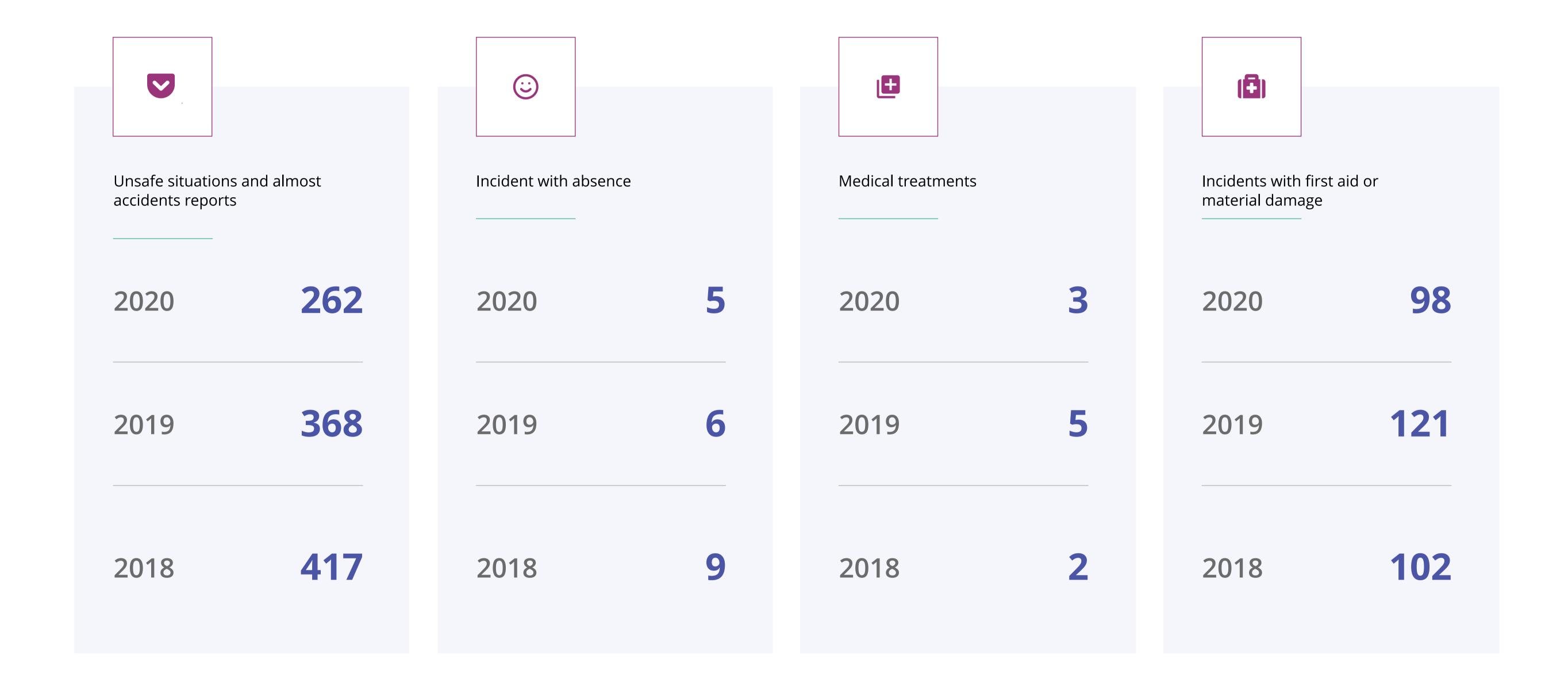
Goal: by 2023 TAUW will emit 50% less CO_2 per FTE compared to 2019; by 2030, the CO_2 reduction will be 100% (with the exception of the "buy" inevitable) and we will be climate neutral.

Emissions from electricity consumption, transport by private vehicles and air traffic Goal: by 2023 TAUW will emit 15% less CO₂ per FTE compared to 2019.

Safety statistics 2020

Due the COVID-19 situation and regional lockdowns, the number of reported incidents has dropped significantly this year as can be seen in the figure below. As in previous years, our occupational safety focus areas are: travelling, exposure to dangerous substances and slipping and tripping hazards. These focus areas will be considered in the updated 2021 annual (country) safety plans, as we aim to reduce incidents related to these matters

Customer satisfaction
